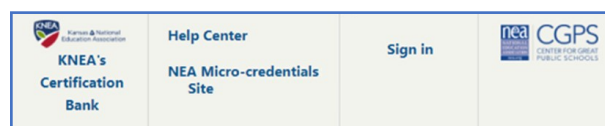
HOW TO TURN YOUR COMPLETED NEA MICRO-CREDENTIALS INTO GRADUATE LEVEL COLLEGE CREDIT

### What are Micro-Credentials?

- ◆ Micro-Credentials offer personalized learning for educators.
- ◆ NEA offers over 100 micro-credentials at no cost to KNEA member educators.
- ◆ These micro-credentials are educator created and educator reviewed.
- ◆ Micro-credentials are competency-based recognition to support educators developing skills and acquiring knowledge to improve classroom practices that support student success.



### To get started



**Create Account** Navigate to the KNEA landing page [nea.certificationbank.com/Kansas](http://nea.certificationbank.com/Kansas) and create your account.

**Select** Browse for topics that interest you. View the micro-credentials by clicking on the image. Select and save the course syllabus. Before you apply...

**Confirm** Confirm with your district PDC to gain approval for submission as professional development points or graduate-level college credit through Baker University.

**Earn** Upload and submit evidence required to earn the micro-credential, pass, and receive the micro-credential from NEA.

**Apply** **KNEA MEMBERS ONLY** process to apply:

1. Access or create your NEA edCommunities account, and request to join the group: "EDC KNEA Micro-Credentials/Baker Univ." The link to apply for graduate-level college credit with Baker University may be found on the group page.
2. Follow the link and complete application. Tuition: \$80/credit hour
3. Upload evidence of successful micro-credential completion. Each subtopic equals one graduate level college credit.
